Submission Deadlines: Postmarked, delivered or emailed¹ on or before 4:00 pm:

Friday, September 30, 2010

Notification will only be provided to the approved grant proposals -generally within two weeks of the submittal deadline date. If you do not receive a notification, your request will automatically advance to the next submission deadline.

(preference will be given to requests that incorporate an energy component)
- Are the goals and intended outcome of the project clearly defined?
- Is the budget detailed, reasonable and understandable?
- Does the project have a clear timetable and evaluation procedure?
